

**SUMMERLAND YACHT CLUB**  
**RULES & REGULATIONS FOR CLUB MEMBERS**  
**2011**

The present rights and privileges of each category of membership shall be as follows:

- 1. A FULL MEMBER** shall have the full use of all the Club facilities.
- 2. A LIFE MEMBER** shall have the full use of all the Club facilities.
- 3. AN HONORARY MEMBER** shall have the full use of all the Club facilities.
- 4. AN ASSOCIATE MEMBER** shall have the full use of the Club-house facilities.
- 5. A FAMILY MEMBER**, his/her spouse and all the children over the age of nineteen shall have the full use of all the Club facilities.
- 6.** Members shall enter the names of all guests in the *Visitor's Book*. The member must remain with the guest for the whole time that the guest is in the Club House. (Liquor Control Board Regulations.)
- 7.** A member shall not knowingly remove, injure, destroy or damage any property of the Club and shall make restitution for the same if called upon to do so by the Executive Committee.
- 8.** A Member shall not cause any communication in whatever form to be exhibited on Club notice boards or premises without permission of Office Manager
- 9.** A member shall settle an' indebtedness for refreshment or otherwise before leaving the Club premises. or in accordance with any by-law relating to the settlement of such indebtedness.
- 10.** Complaints of any nature relating to the management of the Club premises shall be addressed in writing to the Commodore. Under no circumstances shall a servant of the Club be personally reprimanded by a member.
- 11.** Any person who is a competitor or crew member in any race sponsored by or on behalf of the Club is entitled to the use the Club premises within a period of 24 hours before and after the race in which the are competing.
- 12.** No animals are to be brought into the Club House. (This excludes seeing-eye dogs.) The Club serves food and therefore must comply with the rules set out for all restaurants. Members who feel compelled to bring animals to Club facilities are required to keep them under leash control at all times and are to clean up and dispose of any excrement caused by the animals.
- 13.** Children under fourteen years of age may only be admitted to the Club House premises for the service of food.
- 14.** Cars may only be parked in areas designated for such parking so as not to cause an obstruction to other cars or to the approaches to the Club premises. Members should refrain from using the parking stalls of the Directors or Staff.
- 15.** The Club premises shall be open to members at such times as the Executive Committee shall direct.

**16.** The use of the Club House for private functions may be approved by the Executive Committee. If approved, the person applying must remain on the Club premises for the duration of the function and assume responsibility for the conduct of guests and the physical condition of the Club House and equipment. Fees for the private use of the club House by a member will be set by the Executive Committee.

**17.** Notwithstanding Article 16, members will retain their right to use the Clubs bar and washroom facilities during such private functions.

**18.** Members and guests are to be suitably dressed when in the Club House. Shirts and shoes are mandatory.

**19.** Foul and abusive language will not be tolerated in the Club House or Patio.

**20.** No liquor or beer may be brought into the Club House by a member or a guest. All liquor and beer sold in the Club House must be consumed in the Club House.

**21.** Members shall be responsible for the orderly behavior of themselves and their guests at all times.
