



SUMMERLAND YACHT CLUB RECIPROCAL MOORAGE POLICY 2016

The Summerland Yacht Club (SYC) is a private, non-profit yacht club and it is the policy of the SYC not to offer the general public reciprocal moorage at our club.

The SYC welcomes all reciprocal Yacht Club members in good standing, on a first come first serve space-available basis from time to time throughout the moorage year.

All reciprocal members **must** apply in advance for moorage through the SYC office 5 days prior to arrival to verify moorage availability and receive approval.

All reciprocal moorage requests are to be filled out online through our website. You will be asked to attach the following to your request:

- Valid Club membership Card.
- Copy of Valid Insurance Certificate (minimum \$2 million liability coverage required starting in 2017)

Reciprocal moorage requests for SYC sponsored events will be given priority over non-event related requests. Please note, no reciprocal moorage offered during blackout dates for Giants Head Regatta and All Club End to End Regatta, other than those participating.

Please advise SYC of any cancellations at least two days prior to confirmed booking date.

Reciprocal Privileges

1. SYC has three (3) designated reciprocal moorage slips marked by signage. Members of clubs to whom Reciprocal Privileges have been extended by SYC will be offered the following:

- a) Temporary moorage and use of the clubhouse facilities in SYC Marina up to a maximum of three (3) nights per visit.
- b) Additional moorage time may be available at the discretion of the Moorage Director or designate and will be charged in accordance with the follows rates:
 - Security Key Fob: \$40.00 (refundable).
 - Three (3) nights- No Charge
 - Additional nights to a maximum of seven (7): subject to availability and approval: \$ 40.00 per night
- c) Following two (2) "no-shows", if a reservation is made and the reciprocal member does not show up or cancel their reservation, their reciprocal member privileges will be revoked for the remainder of the season.
